

Minster Lovell Neighbourhood Plan Survey update

A survey is a key means of finding out what residents think about a range of issues. The survey is an important part of the evidence base underpinning the Neighbourhood Plan, with the findings helping guide the next stage of plan-making.

- The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group hand delivered 712 surveys
- We received 200 responses (28% response rate)

Here is just some of what you told us:

- 74% **would not like to see** new housing development in the Village over the next 15 years
- 73% are **very concerned** about new housing development in the Village over the next 15 years
- If **you are concerned** about the potential allocation of new homes in Minster Lovell please tell us why:

The Top 3 Answers:

Impact on infrastructure 99%

Impact on roads and traffic 95%

Impact on rural setting and keeping the village a village 89%

- In response to the question how would you like to see Minster Lovell to be described in 15 years' time:

Top answers: **Safe 86% Friendly 82% Attractive 75%**

- In response to the question do you have a housing need

12% said yes

- What type of housing would suit best suit your need

61% said Bungalow

- In response to the question do you think the Neighbourhood Plan should do more to conserve and enhance nature biodiversity and wildlife

87% said Yes
