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MINSTER LOVELL PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCIES

Do you want to help make a difference by influencing decisions that affect your community?

Minster Lovell Parish Council is looking for new Parish Councillor's to represent the interests of the Parish. You will be involved in areas such as consultation on planning applications, setting the Parish Council's budget, community safety, allotments, playing fields, looking after the environment, some aspect to highways and decision making on providing grants to local organisations.

A desire to help others and understand the needs of different groups in the community is an important part of your role as councillor.

Council meetings are where you play your part as a decision maker. There is one meeting per month which is usually held on the third Monday of the month and one annual meeting.

This is a voluntary and rewarding role and you will be supported through mentoring and optional courses, delivered by the Oxfordshire Association of Local Councils, which can be online or face to face.

Criteria for Standing as a Parish Councillor

Candidates must fit at least **one** of the following criteria –

- On the Electoral Register (i.e. registered to vote) for the Parish
- Have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish/community area over the last 12 months
- Lived within 3 miles of the parish over the last 12 months
- Their principal place of work is in the Parish and has been for at least 12 months

Applications for co-option will need to be received by **Friday 16th January 2025**.

Applications received will be considered at the next Parish Council meeting scheduled for **Monday 19th January 2026**.
